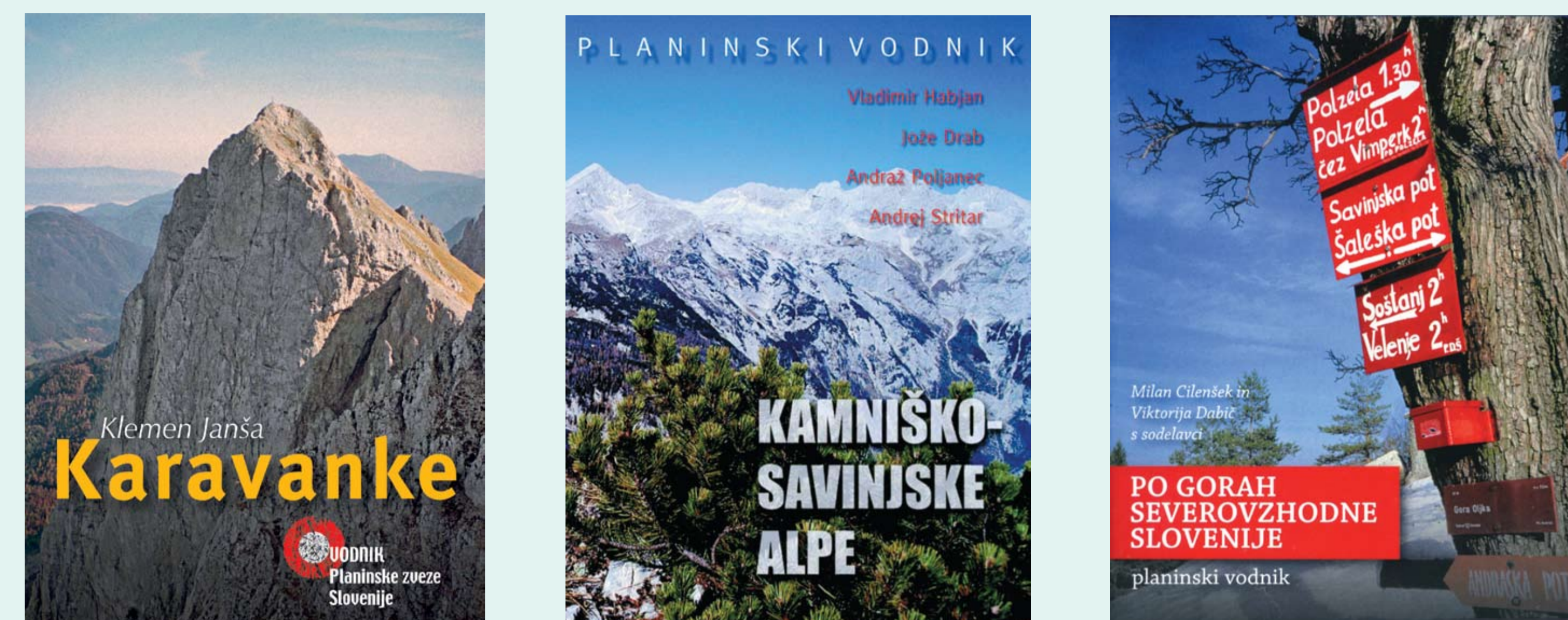




Z začetki obiskovanj in raziskovanj gora so nastajali prvi zapisi o doživljajih in lepotah gora, ki pomenujo začetke planinske literature. Dandanes Planinska zveza Slovenije v okviru Planinske založbe izdaja planinske zemljevide (Triglav, Kamniško-Savinjske Alpe, Pohorje, Dolenjska, Nanos ...), pa planinske (Kamniško-Savinjske Alpe, Karavanke, Po gorah severovzhodne Slovenije, Polhograjsko hribovje, Škofjeloško in Cerkljansko hribovje ...) in plezalne vodnike (Vršič, Robanov kot, Logarska dolina – vzhodni in zahodni del, Koroške, Bohinjske stene ...) ki pokrivajo ves gorski svet Slovenije. Izdaja tudi strokovno (Planinska šola, Vodniški učbenik, Priročnik za markaciste, Planinski tabori-priročnik ...) in leposlovno literaturo (Slovensko planinstvo, Po svoji sledi, Iveri z Grintovcev, Gola gora ...) ter druge edicije, namenjene posameznikom in planinskim društvom.

V okviru Planinske založbe PZS deluje Založniški odbor, ki ga sestavljajo člani, ki pokrivajo eno izmed navedenih področij. Odbor usmerja, usklajuje in pospešuje dejavnosti na področju založniškega delovanja Planinske zveze Slovenije. Koordinira, usmerja in usklajuje planinsko založništvo tudi v okviru ostalih komisij in odborov Upravnega odbora PZS. Svoje aktivnosti izvaja na podlagi programa dela, ki je sprejet za tekoče leto.

Založniška dejavnost se razvija naprej in sledi potrebam uporabnikov strokovne ter druge literature. Sodelujemo s številnimi avtorji, ki so naši dolgoletni sodelavci, hkrati pa želimo kot založba ponuditi možnost uveljavitve tudi mlajšim avtorjem.



The earliest visits and explorations of the mountains gave rise to the creation of written accounts in which mountaineers described their experiences and the beauty of the mountains. These accounts mark the beginning of the mountaineering culture. In the framework of Planinska založba, the Alpine Association of Slovenia (Planinska zveza Slovenije, PZS) publishes mountain maps (e.g. Triglav, the Kamnik-Savinja Alps, the Pohorje, Dolenjska, Nanos), as well as mountaineering guides (e.g. the Kamnik-Savinja Alps, the Karavanke, the mountains of North-East Slovenia, the Polhograjsko hribovje, the Škofjeloško hribovje, and the Cerkljansko hribovje) and climbing guidebooks (e.g. Vršič, Robanov kot, Logarska dolina – the eastern and western part, the rock faces of Koroška, and Bohinj). Its range of publications covers the entire mountainous territory of Slovenia. Planinska založba also publishes professional books (e.g. a mountaineering school handbook, and handbook for voluntary mountain guides of PZS, waymarkers, and mountain camps), literature (Slovensko planinstvo (Slovene mountaineering), Po svoji sledi (My personal mountaineering history), Iveri z Grintovcev (Fragments from the Grintovci Range), Gola gora (Nanga Parbat: Naked Mountain), and other publications intended for individuals and alpine clubs.

Planinska založba operates a Publishing Committee, which is made up of several members, each of them responsible for one of Planinska založba's main areas of activity. The Committee directs, coordinates, and promotes the publishing efforts of the Alpine Association of Slovenia. It also manages, runs, and coordinates mountaineering publication activities of other commissions and committees of the Management Board of the Alpine Association of Slovenia. The Publishing Committee carries out its activities on the basis of a plan of work for the current year.

Planinska založba is committed to meeting the changing needs of the users of professional and other literature. It maintains good long-term relations with many established authors and is dedicated to assisting new writers establish themselves in the publishing sector.
